

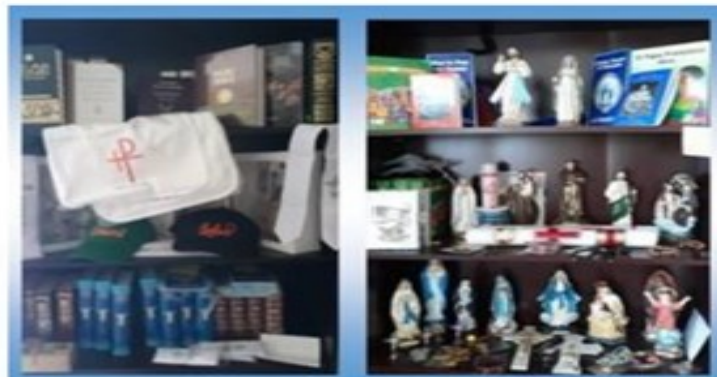

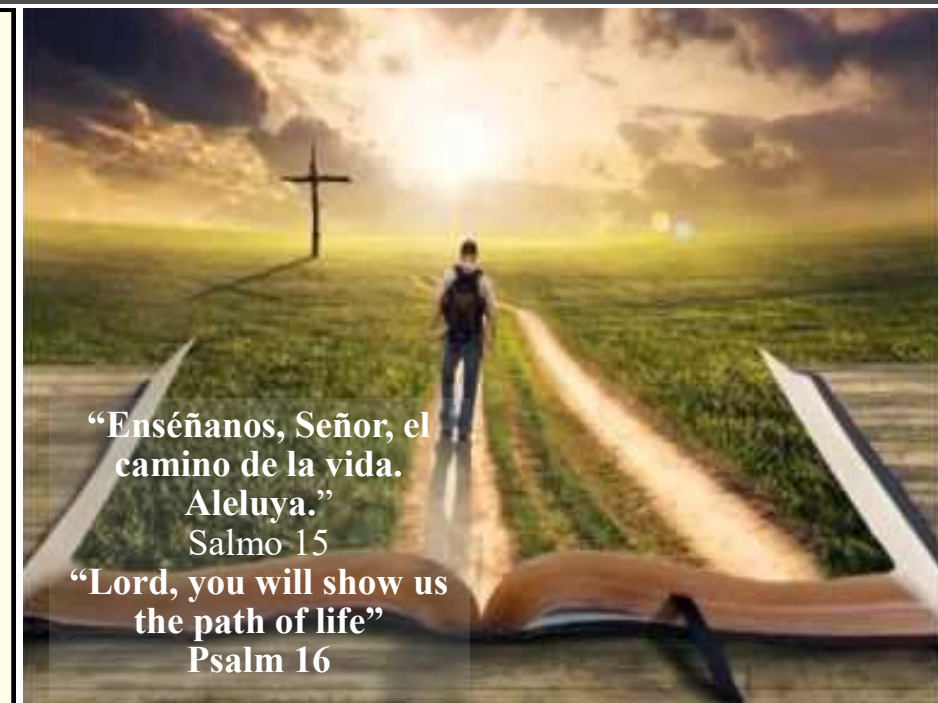

From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, April 23th , 2023 – Third Sunday - Cycle A

Readings: Acts 2:14, 22-33, **Psalm 16** “Lord, you will show us the path of life”, 1 Peter 1:17-21, Luke 24:13-35

Easter we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ from the dead. We celebrate Jesus who is with his church, watching over it, helping it to grow. It is the celebration of divine forgiveness, divine restoration. Victory over the power of evil, over the power of sin and death.

My dear brothers and sisters. This Easter that we celebrate will just come and go if you have not lived under the experience of it. If nothing has touched you, nothing has transformed you, nothing has given you a sign that Jesus did all these for you. It will just pass and you will forget.

Jesus did not finish the work of evangelization. All he did was give some people some experiences that will change their lives, experiences that will turn their lives, that will leave a mark on their lives so that wherever they go they will say I have experienced what I am sharing. At the call of Peter, Andrew, James and John. The raising of Lazarus to life. The raising of the daughter of Jairus and the son of the widow of Naim. The multiplication of bread and five to feed the five thousand men. Miracle at the wedding of Cana. Transfiguration. So that Peter can say that I have been on the mountain with him when Elijah and Moses appeared to him.

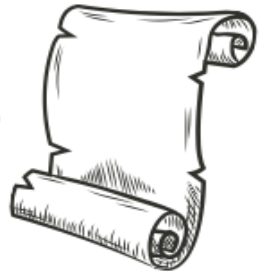
The Psalmist says in Psalm “this is what causes my grief that the right hand of the Most High has changed”. Experiences matter in this mission. Because there comes a time that the ways of the Lord will change. In the last three years the disciples have been with the Lord. In the gospel we encounter two of Jesus’ disciples who had lost hope, given up on the mission and were returning to a village seven miles from Jerusalem called Emmaus. The risen Jesus accompanied them, interpreted to them the scriptures while they did not recognize that the stranger they were talking to was the risen lord. They will later realize at the breaking of bread that the stranger was the Lord and filled with great joy and enthusiasm they will return to Jerusalem to announce to the others their experience.

My dear brothers and sister, do not forget the experiences you have had with the Lord. Do not forget how far he has brought you. The risen Lord continues to lead us into a deeper experience of him. May he bless us in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

Domingo, 23 de abril de 2023 - III Domingo de Pascua - Ciclo A

Lecturas: Hechos 2, 14. 22-33, Salmo 15 “Enseñanos, Señor, el camino de la vida. Aleluya”, 1 Pedro 1, 17-21, Lucas 24, 13-35

En la Pascua celebramos la resurrección de nuestro Señor Jesucristo de entre los muertos. Celebramos a Jesús que está con su iglesia, velando por ella, ayudándola a crecer. Es la celebración del perdón divino, la restauración divina. Victoria sobre el poder del mal, sobre el poder del pecado y de la muerte.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas. Esta Pascua que celebramos vendrá y se irá si no has vivido la experiencia de ella. Si nada te ha tocado, nada te ha transformado, nada te ha dado una señal de que Jesús hizo todo esto por ti. Simplemente pasará y lo olvidarás.

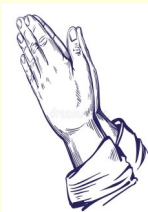

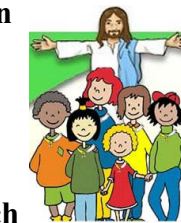
