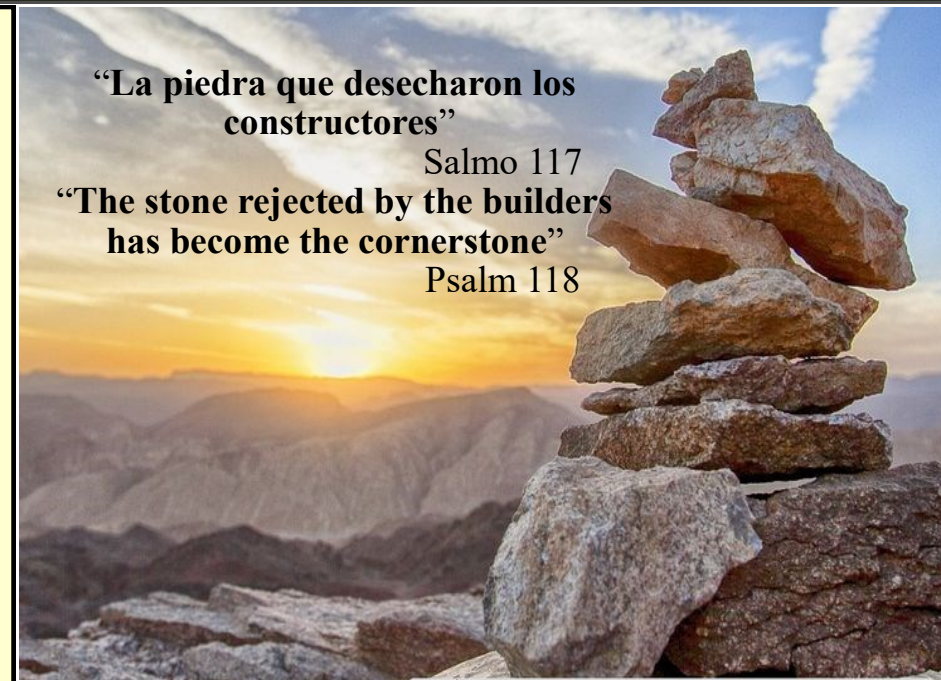

**From the Pastor's Desk...**

**Sunday, April 21, 2024 – Fourth Easter Sunday - Cycle B**

**Readings:** Acts 4:8-12, Psalm 118 “The stone rejected by the builders has become the cornerstone”, 1 John 3:1-2, John 10:11-18

**WE NEED A GOOD SHEPHERD**

Life is worth living only if it is to surrender. Christ is the Good Shepherd who gives his life for his sheep - he knows us each by name. The shepherds of our time are not only the priests, but all the coherent Christians. Today's Gospel speaks of shepherds and of mercenaries. Only the first are capable of giving their life for his flock.

Sisters and brothers:

1. Jesus ends the parable by saying: "I am the Good Shepherd." You and I are also the good shepherd if we meet the conditions: giving life for the sheep; know them by name, living among them by helping them with their problems and concerns, especially those outside the fold. Giving life is the supreme example of love. There are many who live off the sheep, taking advantage of the position and turning it into power and control, rather it should be responsibility and service. Being a shepherd is not easy. Knowing and giving life implies a personal, intimate, dynamic, and exciting relationship.
2. The teaching of Jesus is innovative and illuminates with a new light the relations of power and authority. "The good shepherd, says Vatican Council II, is known for the goodness of heart, sincerity, strength and steadfastness of the soul, and the constant concern of justice." We can be good shepherds or bad shepherds for others. Christ is the shepherd par excellence, but there are also other good shepherds among us.

Good shepherds can be found in every state of life, all professions, and all social classes. They must always be "self-giving" (to die to self) - to sacrifice, be loyal, and be an example of loving one another.

3. The Fourth Sunday of Easter is the day of vocations. The world needs to be evangelized with new methods, new enthusiasm, new language, says the Pope. We need priests who devote their lives to serving the elderly, the handicapped, the sick, the poor, drug addicts, and children. Today priests are needed more than a king, the military, bankers, doctors, and teachers, because they can replace all of them, but none can replace a priest if he were missing. Without priests, the world would die the worst hunger without that little bit of bread and that little bit of wine that are the focus of all liturgical celebrations.

Brothers and sisters: Let us pray that the Holy Spirit brings us many vocations. Many people can and do not want. Many want but cannot. A vocation is a calling from God. If any of your children has expressed **an interest in a vocation, thank God for that. Protect them in their difficulties, pray for him to be generous; support their decisions. It will be the pride of your home and a blessing from heaven.**

## Palabras del Párroco

**Domingo, 21 de abril de 2024 - Cuarto domingo de Pascua- Ciclo B**

**Lecturas: Hechos 4, 8-12, Salmo 117 "La piedra que desecharon los constructores es ahora la piedra angular. Aleluya", 1 Juan 3, 1-2, Juan 10, 11-18**

### NECESITAMOS UN BUEN PASTOR

**La vida merece ser vivida solamente si es para entregarla.** Cristo es el Buen Pastor que da la vida por sus ovejas, las conoce por su nombre. Los pastores de nuestro tiempo no son solamente los sacerdotes, sino todos los cristianos coherentes. El Evangelio habla hoy de pastores y de mercenarios. Sólo los primeros son capaces de dar la vida por su rebaño.

Hermanas y hermanos:

**1. Jesús termina diciendo en la parábola : "Yo soy el Buen Pastor".** Tú y yo también lo somos si cumplimos las condiciones: dar la vida por las ovejas; conocerlas por su nombre; vivir entre ellas participando de sus problemas y preocupándonos especialmente por las que están fuera del redil. Dar la vida es la suprema muestra de amor. Hay muchos que viven de las ovejas, que se aprovechan del puesto y convierten en poder y dominio lo que debe ser responsabilidad y servicio. Estar con las ovejas no es cosa fácil. Conocer y dar la vida implica una relación personal, íntima, dinámica, vivificante.

**2. La pedagogía de Jesús es innovadora e ilumina con una luz nueva las relaciones de poder y autoridad.** "Al buen pastor -dice el Concilio Vaticano II- se le conoce por la bondad de corazón, la sinceridad, la fortaleza de alma y la constancia, la asidua preocupación de la justicia". Podemos ser pastores buenos, malos o incluso lobos para los demás. Cristo es el pastor por excelencia, pero hay también otros buenos pastores entre nosotros.

Los encontramos en todos los estados de vida, en todas las profesiones, en todas las clases sociales. Si no siempre "dan la vida" en el sentido de morir físicamente, dan a todos los hombres su sacrificio, su lealtad, su ejemplo y su amor de hermanos.

**3. El cuarto domingo de pascua es el día de las las vocaciones.** El mundo necesita ser evangelizado con nuevos métodos, nuevo entusiasmo, nuevo lenguaje, como dice el Papa. El Señor necesita sacerdotes que dediquen su vida a servir a los ancianos, los minusválidos, los enfermos, los pobres, los drogadictos, los niños. El sacerdote hace falta hoy más que un rey, más que un militar, más que un banquero, más que un médico, más que un maestro; porque él puede reemplazar a todos pero ninguno puede reemplazarlo a él; si él faltase, el mundo moriría de la peor hambre, pues lo dejaría sin ese poquito de pan y sin ese poquito de vino que son el centro de todas las celebraciones litúrgicas.

Hermanas y hermanos: **Oremos para que el Espíritu suscite muchas y santas vocaciones.** Muchos pueden y no quieren. Muchos quieren pero no pueden. La vocación es un llamado de Dios. Y si alguno de tus hijos ha manifestado inquietud vocacional, agradece a Dios esa elección; protégelo en sus dificultades; reza por él para que sea generoso; apóyalo en sus decisiones. Será el orgullo de tu casa y una bendición del cielo.

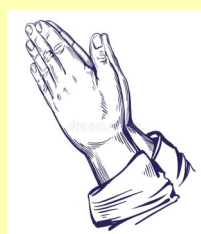

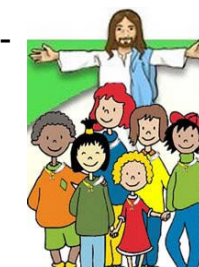
