From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, July 30th, 2023 – Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle A

Readings: Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14, Psalm 97 “**The Lord is king, the Most High over all the earth**”, 2 Peter 1:16-19, Matthew 17:1-9

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, retreat is very important in our Christian life. It can be defined as a definite time spent away from one's normal life for the purpose of reconnecting, usually in prayer, with God. In today's gospel account, Jesus retreats. 'Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain, by themselves,' we hear. It seems that Jesus needs to get away from it all, and what better place to get away from it all than a mountaintop? This retreat comes at a turning point in Jesus' ministry – and, coincidentally or not, this happens about half way through the gospel according to Matthew. For months, Jesus has been traveling the Galilean countryside, and occasionally beyond its borders; preaching, healing, performing miracles, proclaiming and the good news of kingdom of God. But then the focus and the mood shifts. It all starts when some Pharisees and Sadducees ask Jesus for a sign from heaven, basically questioning his authority. Who are you, Jesus?

This must have led to some self-reflection on the part of Jesus, for shortly thereafter, Jesus asks his disciples, 'Who do people say that the Son of Man is?' And then, 'Who do you say that I am?' He made the first prediction of his passion, death and resurrection and has told his disciples the need for them to deny themselves, carry their cross and follow him. Jesus needed to strengthen them to face what was to happen to him in Jerusalem. The disciples needed a confirmation that Jesus' evaluation of the will of God is correct. He took Peter, James and John from their ordinary day life up the mountain to have a deeper revelation of the person and mission of Jesus. They climbed the mountain of prayer. On that mountain, they experienced another side of Jesus that they have never seen. "His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him."

And they got the confirmation from the voice in the cloud that said "listen to him". Our spiritual exercise are meant to help us to listen to Jesus who speaks to us about God's plan for us. When we learn to listen to God, we grow in faith because the Word of God enlightens us and nourishes our faith. My dear friends, retreat is a time when the Lord calls us from our ordinary day life, from our experiences and situation, joy, anxiety, fears, securities, to be with him on the mountain. To experience the Lord who is committed in forming his character in us. We all get tired and need time to think afresh about our image of God, our commitment to him and our mission in the service of the Kingdom which Jesus entrusted to us. There are moments that what we need most is to find a new enthusiasm and a new affirmation from the Lord. who wants to say to speak to you. May the grace of God lead and direct us. In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 6 de agosto de 2023 - Fiesta de la Transfiguración del Señor - Ciclo A

Lecturas: Daniel 7, 9-10. 13-14, Salmo 96 "The Lord is king, the Most High over all the earth", 2 Pedro 1, 16-19, Mateo 17, 1-9

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, el retiro es muy importante en nuestra vida cristiana. Puede definirse como un tiempo definido que se pasa fuera de la vida normal de uno con el propósito de reconectarse, usualmente en oración, con Dios. En el relato del evangelio de hoy, Jesús se retira. 'Jesús tomó consigo a Pedro, a Santiago y a su hermano Juan y los llevó solos a un monte alto', escuchamos. Parece que Jesús necesita alejarse de todo, y ¿qué mejor lugar para alejarse de todo que la cima de una montaña? Este retiro llega en un punto de inflexión en el ministerio de Jesús y, casualmente o no, esto sucede aproximadamente a la mitad del evangelio según Mateo. Durante meses, Jesús ha estado recorriendo la campiña galilea, y ocasionalmente más allá de sus fronteras; predicando, sanando, haciendo milagros, proclamando y las buenas nuevas del reino de Dios. Pero luego el enfoque y el estado de ánimo cambian. Todo comienza cuando unos fariseos y saduceos le piden a Jesús una señal del cielo, básicamente cuestionando su autoridad. ¿Quién eres, Jesús?

Esto debe haber llevado a cierta autorreflexión por parte de Jesús, porque poco después, Jesús pregunta a sus discípulos: "¿Quién dice la gente que es el Hijo del Hombre?" Y luego, "¿Quién decís que soy yo?" Hizo la primera predicción de su pasión, muerte y resurrección y ha dicho a sus discípulos la necesidad de que se nieguen a sí mismos, carguen con su cruz y lo sigan. Jesús necesitaba fortalecerlos para enfrentar lo que le sucedería a él en Jerusalén. Los discípulos necesitaban una confirmación de que la evaluación de Jesús de la voluntad de Dios es correcta. Llevó a Pedro, Santiago y Juan de su vida cotidiana a la montaña para tener una revelación más profunda de la persona y la misión de Jesús. Subieron al monte de la oración. En esa montaña, experimentaron otro lado de Jesús que nunca habían visto. "Su rostro resplandeció como el sol y su ropa se volvió blanca como la luz. Y he aquí, se les aparecieron Moisés y Elías, conversando con él".

Y obtuvieron la confirmación de la voz en la nube que dijo "escúchalo". Nuestro ejercicio espiritual está destinado a ayudarnos a escuchar a Jesús que nos habla sobre el plan de Dios para nosotros. Cuando aprendemos a escuchar a Dios, crecemos en la fe porque la Palabra de Dios nos ilumina y nutre nuestra fe. Queridos amigos, el retiro es un tiempo en el que el Señor nos llama desde nuestro día a día, desde nuestras experiencias y situaciones, alegrías, angustias, miedos, seguridades, para estar con él en la montaña. Experimentar al Señor que se compromete a formar su carácter en nosotros. Todos nos cansamos y necesitamos tiempo para repensar nuestra imagen de Dios, nuestro compromiso con él y nuestra misión al servicio del Reino que Jesús nos ha confiado. Hay momentos que lo que más necesitamos es encontrar un nuevo entusiasmo y una nueva afirmación del Señor. quien quiere decir que te hable. Que la gracia de Dios nos guíe y dirija. En el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.

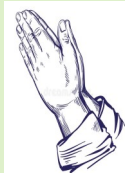
