From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, December 10, 2023 – Second Sunday of Advent - Cycle B

Readings: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11, Psalm 80 “Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation”, 1 Peter 3: 8-14, Mark 1:1-8

The Martyrs of la Florida

55) Fray Domingo Criado, O.F.M. (1705)

Fray Domingo Criado, O.F.M., from the Province of Santiago (Spain) refused to abandon his vulnerable and dispossessed flock in the aftermath of the invasions of North Florida. He accompanied them as they wandered through the woods and eventually found refuge along a river some ten or twelve leagues from St. Augustine. He was subsequently captured and imprisoned. According to reports from some Christian Native Americans who escaped, Fray Domingo was reduced to slavery and died some months later near present-day Macon, Georgia.

56) Don Patricio (Spring 1706)

Don Patricio de Hinachuba, a well-educated native of Ivitachuco, a town in Apalachee Province, was known as the “penpal” of the King due to his correspondence seeking justice for the Apalachee people. In the aftermath of the English devastation of Apalachee in 1704 Don Patricio and an Apalachee remnant moved east and settled first in Abosaya, near present-day Gainesville, and then on the southern outskirts of St. Augustine. He was killed in the spring of 1706 by a band of Creek warriors seeking to destroy the remaining Apalachee Christians.

57) Fr. Felipe Orbalaes y Abreo (September 1, 1712)

Fr. Orbalaes, a barber-surgeon of the Order of Hospitallers of St. John of God who was in charge of a hospital in Pensacola, was killed on September 1, 1712 when three groups of Creek warriors ambushed Spanish soldiers who were providing protection for laborers cutting wood outside of the fort.

58) Fray Tiburcio de Osorio, O.F.M. (between September 1, 1712 and July 1715)

Tiburcio de Osorio, O.F.M., a native of Havana who had ministered in Apalachee at the time of Col. Moore's invasion, was captured in Pensacola by the Creek on September 1, 1712. Evidence suggests that he was taken into custody to the homeland of the (Upper) Creek, which was near the present-day town of Montgomery, Alabama. He was murdered while in captivity.

Next week we will continue with The Cause for beatification.

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 10 de diciembre de 2023 - Segundo domingo de Adviento- Ciclo B

Los Martines de la Florida

55) Fray Domingo Criado, O.F.M. (1705) Fray Domingo Criado, O.F.M., de la Provincia de Santiago (España) se negó a abandonar a su vulnerable y desposeído rebaño tras las invasiones del Norte de Florida. Los acompañó mientras vagaban por el bosque y finalmente encontraron refugio junto a un río a unas diez o doce leguas de San Agustín. Posteriormente fue capturado y encarcelado. Según informes de algunos nativos americanos cristianos que escaparon, Fray Domingo fue reducido a esclavitud y murió algunos meses después cerca de la actual Macon, Georgia.

56) Don Patricio (primavera de 1706) Don Patricio de Hinachuba, un nativo bien educado de Ivitachuco, un pueblo en la provincia de Apalachee, era conocido como el "amigo por correspondencia" del Rey debido a su correspondencia buscando justicia para el pueblo Apalachee. A raíz de la devastación inglesa de Apalachee en 1704, Don Patricio y un remanente de Apalachee se trasladaron al este y se establecieron primero en Abosaya, cerca de la actual Gainesville, y luego en las afueras del sur de San Agustín. Fue asesinado en la primavera de 1706 por un grupo de guerreros creek que buscaban destruir a los cristianos apalaches restantes.

57) P. Phelipe Orbalaes y Abreo (1 de septiembre de 1712) P. Orbalaes, un barbero-cirujano de la Orden de Hospitalarios de San Juan de Dios que estaba a cargo de un hospital en Pensacola, murió el 1 de septiembre de 1712 cuando tres grupos de guerreros creek tendieron una emboscada a los soldados españoles que brindaban protección a los trabajadores que cortaban madera fuera del fuerte.

58) Fray Tiburcio de Osorio, O.F.M. (entre el 1 de septiembre de 1712 y julio de 1715) Tiburcio de Osorio, O.F.M., nativo de La Habana que había ministrado en Apalachee en el momento de la invasión del Coronel Moore, fue capturado en Pensacola por el Creek el 1 de septiembre de 1712. La evidencia sugiere que fue llevado bajo custodia a la tierra natal de los (Upper) Creek, que estaba cerca de la actual ciudad de Montgomery, Alabama. Fue asesinado mientras estaba en cautiverio.
