The Cause for Beatification

"The Story of the promotion of the Cause of the Martyrs in the United States is in itself simple, one that might be expressed in few words; the magnitude of the Cause, the motives of justice and charity underlying it, and the glorious end in view, might well fill volumes." --Rev. Msgr. James M. Powers, LL.D.

Commission of the Beatification of the US Martyrs, 1957

Status of the Beatification Effort

Bishop William A. Wack of Pensacola-Tallahassee is the ‘competent bishop’ for the beatification effort of the Martyrs of *La Florida*. The bishops across the Southeast who have martyrdoms from historic Florida in their dioceses have been invited to participate in the beatification cause. Several bishops have given their assent to include their martyrs in the united cause. The Congregation for the Causes of Saints has permitted the unified group cause because all of the presumed martyrs were killed in the evangelization of *La Florida*. Since the cause opened in October of 2015, the timeline to close the diocesan phase and to move toward beatification rests squarely on the shoulders of the scholars who form the historical commission. The commission must complete the identification and verification of all supporting documents. Further, the historians will be required to give sworn testimony to the tribunal concerning the strength or weakness of each proposed martyr in each event.

Since that time, members of the Historical Commission have been extensively researching numerous individuals from the sixteenth, seventeenth, and eighteenth centuries who are reported to have died for the faith within the land that was once known as La Florida. These investigations have taken members of the Historical Commission to archives in Florida, Georgia, Missouri, and Louisiana, as well as Cuba, Mexico, Spain, and Rome. In keeping with the Church’s prudent requirements, the Historical Commission has rigorously examined each and every report of martyrdom in order to assess its accuracy and credibility.

We will continue next week with The Cause for Beatification

Your Eminence,

As suggested in your letter of 26 August 2015 (Prot. N. 3233-1/15), the Historical Commission of the Inquiry on the life, martyrdom, and the reputation of martyrdom and of intercessory power of the alleged martyrs **Antonio Inija** and **56 Companions**, who were killed during the evangelization of historic *La Florida*, has clarified the number and identity of those who will be included in the Cause. The official list of 57 candidates is attached to this letter.

Now that this list is made, I humbly ask Your Eminence, in accordance with the Norms of the Congregation of the Causes of Saints (*Normae servandis*, no. 14c, *Sanctorum Mater*, art. 45, § 1), to seek whether there is, on the part of the Holy See, any obstacle for the continuation of the Diocesan Inquiry of the Servants of God (*nihil obstat*).

La Causa de Beatificación

"La Historia de la promoción de la Causa de los Mártires en los Estados Unidos es en sí misma simple, una que podría expresarse en pocas palabras; la magnitud de la Causa, los motivos de justicia y caridad subyacentes en ella, y el glorioso final en vista, bien podría llenar volúmenes." --Rdo. Mons. James M. Powers, LL.D. Comisión de Beatificación de los Mártires Estadounidenses, 1957 Estado del proceso de beatificación

El obispo William A. Wack de Pensacola-Tallahassee es el "obispo competente" para el esfuerzo de beatificación de los Mártires de La Florida. Los obispos de todo el sudeste que tienen martirios de la Florida histórica en sus diócesis han sido invitados a participar en la causa de beatificación. Varios obispos han dado su consentimiento para incluir a sus mártires en la causa unida. La Congregación para las Causas de los Santos ha permitido la causa grupal unificada porque todos los presuntos mártires fueron asesinados en la evangelización de La Florida.

Desde que se abrió la causa en octubre de 2015, el cronograma para cerrar la fase diocesana y avanzar hacia la beatificación recae directamente sobre los hombros de los académicos que formaron la comisión histórica. La comisión debe completar la identificación y verificación de todos los documentos de respaldo. Además, los historiadores deberán dar testimonio jurado ante el tribunal sobre la fuerza o debilidad de cada mártir propuesto en cada evento. Desde entonces, los miembros de la Comisión Histórica han estado investigando exhaustivamente a numerosos individuos de los siglos XVI, XVII y XVIII que, según se informa, murieron por la fe dentro de la tierra que una vez fue conocida como La Florida. Estas investigaciones han llevado a miembros de la Comisión Histórica a archivos de Florida, Georgia, Missouri y Luisiana, así como a Cuba, México, España y Roma. De acuerdo con las prudentes exigencias de la Iglesia, la Comisión Histórica ha examinado rigurosamente todos y cada uno de los informes de martirio para evaluar su exactitud y credibilidad.

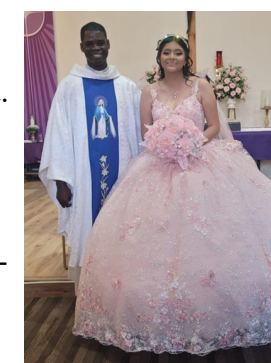
