Sunday, December 3, 2023 – First Sunday of Advent - Cycle B

Readings: Isaiah 63:16b-17, 19b; 64:2-7, Psalm 80 “Lord, make us turn to you; let us see your face and we shall be saved.”, 1 Corinthians 1:3-9, Mark 13:33-37

The Martyrs of la Florida

After suffering from dawn until dusk, Antonio received a great gift: the Blessed Mother appeared to him. Antonio declared that the Most Holy Virgin was helping him to endure his martyrdom. The extraordinary faith and holy death of these Florida natives captured the admiration of the Spanish King, Philip V, who directed his ambassador in Rome to inform the Pope of this event.

31) Fray Manuel de Mendoza, O.F.M. (June 3, 1704) 32) Sacristan

33-34) two-year old Native American (June 3, 1704 or shortly thereafter) and Native American woman of Patale (between June 3 and June 9, 1704)

Fray Manuel de Mendoza, a native of the Castilian town of Medina de Rioseco, served for 26 years in the Florida missions. Known for his generosity to the poor, Fr. Mendoza succeeded Fr. Parga at Mission Patale. Some four months after the carnage in January 1704, the English renewed their attacks on the Florida missions. Fr. Mendoza was shot and burned after he was lured out of his convent. Fr. Mendoza's sacristan was also killed, and the convent was burned. Also killed were a two-year old and a woman who had been taken captive from Patale.

35) Baltasar Francisco (July 4, 1704)

36) Don Pedro Marmolejo (July 4, 1704)

37-51) 15 Apalachee Indians (July 4, 1704) These Spanish soldiers and Native Americans were tortured and crucified on July 4, 1704 a half league west of Mission Patale following the battle that marked the end of the Catholic missions in Apalachee. The English and their Creek allies tied fifteen faithful Apalachee men and two Spanish soldiers to the outdoor Stations of the Cross surrounding the plaza in Patale. They set fires at the foot of these crosses, slashed their captives, and put burning splinters in their wounds. Despite his intense suffering, Baltasar Francisco preached from the cross and called upon the Virgin Mary, confident that she would carry him to God.

52) Timucuan Cacique of San Pedro (August 1704)

53) Timucuan Cacique of San Mateo (August 1704) Following the devastation in Apalachee, English-allied Indians continued to attack the remaining missions in northern Florida. In August of 1704, the Timucuan villages of San Pedro and San Mateo were destroyed and their caciques (leaders) burned.

54) Fray Agustín Ponce de León, O.F.M. (September 3, 1705)

Fr. Agustín Ponce de León, O.F.M., a native of St. Augustine, had gone with Capt. Joseph Begambre in pursuit of some Native Americans who had taken numerous prisoners—women and children—from the town over which Fr. Agustín had care. During a battle at dawn on September 3, Fr. Agustín distinguished himself by encouraging the Spanish and Native Americans and by administering the sacrament of penance to the wounded. Like a “good pastor he gave up his soul in defense of his sheep and the children of his doctrina,” but he managed to bring about the release of the majority of the prisoners.

Los Martires de la Florida

Después de sufrir desde el amanecer hasta el anochecer, Antonio recibió un gran regalo: se le apareció la Santísima Virgen. Antonio declaró que la Santísima Virgen le ayudaba a soportar el martirio. La fe extraordinaria y la santa muerte de estos nativos de Florida captaron la admiración del rey español, Felipe V, quien ordenó a su embajador en Roma que informara al Papa de este acontecimiento.

31) Fray Manuel de Mendoza, O.F.M. (3 de junio de 1704) 32) Sacristán 33-34) nativa americana de dos años (3 de junio de 1704 o poco después) y mujer nativa americana de Patale (entre el 3 de junio y el 9 de junio de 1704) Fray Manuel de Mendoza, natural de la localidad castellana de Medina de Rioseco, sirvió durante 26 años en las misiones de Florida. Conocido por su generosidad hacia los pobres, el P. Mendoza sucedió al P. Parga en Misión Patale. Unos cuatro meses después de la carnicería de enero de 1704, los ingleses renovaron sus ataques contra las misiones de Florida. P. Mendoza fue baleado y quemado después de que lo sacaron de su convento. P. También fue asesinado el sacristán de Mendoza y el convento fue quemado. También fueron asesinados un niño de dos años y una mujer que habían sido capturadas en Patale.

35) Baltasar Francisco (4 de julio de 1704) 36) Don Pedro Marmolejo (4 de julio de 1704) 37-51) 15 indios apalachee (4 de julio de 1704) Estos soldados españoles y nativos americanos fueron torturados y crucificados el 4 de julio de 1704, a media legua al oeste de Misión Patale, después de la batalla que marcó el final de las misiones católicas en Apalachee. Los ingleses y sus aliados creek ataron a quince fieles hombres apalaches y dos soldados españoles al vía crucis al aire libre que rodeaba la plaza de Patale. Prendieron fuego al pie de estas cruces, acuchillaron a sus cautivos y les pusieron astillas ardientes en las heridas. A pesar de su intenso sufrimiento, Baltasar Francisco predicó desde la cruz e invocó a la Virgen María, confiando en que ella lo llevaría a Dios.

52) Timucuan Cacique de San Pedro (agosto de 1704) 53) Timucuan Cacique de San Mateo (agosto de 1704) Tras la devastación en Apalachee, los indios aliados de los ingleses continuaron atacando las misiones restantes en el norte de Florida. En agosto de 1704, los pueblos timucuanos de San Pedro y San Mateo fueron destruidos y sus caciques (líderes) quemados. 54) Fray Agustín Ponce de León, O.F.M. (3 de septiembre de 1705) P. Agustín Ponce de León, O.F.M., natural de San Agustín, había ido con el capitán Joseph Begambre en persecución de unos nativos americanos que habían tomado numerosos prisioneros, mujeres y niños, del pueblo sobre el cual el P. Agustín tuvo cuidado. Durante una batalla al amanecer del 3 de septiembre, el P. Agustín se distinguió por animar a los españoles y nativos americanos y por administrar el sacramento de la penitencia a los heridos. Como "buen pastor entregó su alma en defensa de sus ovejas y de los hijos de su doctrina", pero logró la liberación de la mayoría de los prisioneros.
