From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, February 4, 2024 – Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle B

Curriculum Project

New Materials In Development with Anticipated Release in Late October.

At the height of the COVID-19 pandemic it significantly unsettled people's lives all around the world, turning routines on their heads and leaving people isolated and vulnerable. Many parents transitioned to work from home, while others may continue to face substantial economic difficulty or increased danger or stress in the workplace. Schools sent students home, leaving teachers, parents, and students struggling to adjust to distance learning.

Navigating the complex and developing situation of contagious sickness, social distance, and countless days at home we recognized that families desired educational resources that can be obtained online and at no cost. Out of this came the opportunity for resources contained within a kit that will add some educational fun to strengthen you in maintaining the hope in adversity which the Martyrs of *La Florida* modeled so well.

The Goal - We owe students an accurate, nuanced, and, when possible, inspiring account of the past. Countless priests, caciques, soldiers, farmers, parents, and children of the land the Spanish called *La Florida* died rather than deny what they believed to be true; their stories rightly merit a place in the education of young people today. The Heroes of *La Florida* Curriculum Project will equip educators to hand on the stories of the heroes of the *La Florida* Mission Period in academically demanding and imaginatively engaging ways.

Curriculum Design - We are working to create and provide resources—unit plans, lesson plans, primary source excerpts, biographies, and illustrations—appropriate for students at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. The Catholic people whose stories we seek to tell understood the source and the purpose of freedom. They strove to make their world more loving and just, and they preferred to die rather than lie out of fear. As such, these men, women, and children can be regarded as worthy examples for all people, not just for Catholics.

To this end, we are developing diverse resources for use in Catholic, Christian, home, and even public schools throughout and beyond the state of Florida. All resources will be calibrated to Florida's Sunshine State Standards and will seek to promote in students a true affection for what is good, true, and beautiful.

Catholic school resources will consider explicitly the place of martyrdom within the larger Christian narrative and the universal call to holiness. Public school materials will emphasize in these stories the virtues necessary for the pursuit of justice and the practice of freedom—virtues which yet remain relevant and desirable universally in today's public sphere.

Broader Context - It is easy, but wrong, to tell the story of Florida's past in a way that oversimplifies the situation and thereby glosses over the incredible difficulty through which many individuals lived with great grace and virtue. We hope to provide a space for understanding those Spaniards who throughout their lives opposed the oppression of indigenous peoples and those indigenous peoples of the Apalachee, Timucua, Guale, and other tribes of the Southeast, whose comprehension of Catholic teaching guided their opposition to European abuses. These people, neglected by history books, together defended the faith and the freedom of *La Florida* with perseverance lasting unto death.

Helped by the In God We Trust Foundation, the Black and Indian Missions, and the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops, we seek to translate good history into good educational resources for the sake of helping Floridians encounter the hidden heroism of their state's history.

Proyecto Curricular

Nuevos materiales en desarrollo con lanzamiento previsto para finales de octubre. En el punto álgido de la pandemia de COVID-19, la vida de las personas en todo el mundo trastornó significativamente, trastocando las rutinas y dejando a las personas aisladas y vulnerables. Muchos padres hicieron la transición al trabajo desde casa, mientras que otros pueden seguir enfrentando dificultades económicas sustanciales o un mayor peligro o estrés en el lugar de trabajo. Las escuelas enviaron a los estudiantes a casa, lo que dejó a los maestros, padres y estudiantes luchando por adaptarse al aprendizaje a distancia. Al navegar por la compleja y creciente situación de enfermedades contagiosas, distancia social e innumerables días en casa, reconocimos que las familias deseaban recursos educativos que pudieran obtenerse en línea y sin costo alguno. De esto surgió la oportunidad de obtener recursos contenidos en un kit que agregará algo de diversión educativa para fortalecerlo a mantener la esperanza en la adversidad que tan bien modelaron los Mártires de La Florida.

El objetivo: les debemos a los estudiantes un relato del pasado preciso, matizado y, cuando sea posible, inspirador. Innumerables sacerdotes, caciques, soldados, agricultores, padres e hijos de la tierra que los españoles llamaban La Florida murieron antes que negar lo que creían que era verdad; sus historias merecen con razón un lugar en la educación de los jóvenes de hoy. El Proyecto Curricular Héroes de La Florida equipará a los educadores para transmitir las historias de los héroes del Período de la Misión de La Florida de maneras académicamente exigentes e imaginativamente atractivas.

Diseño curricular: estamos trabajando para crear y proporcionar recursos (planes de unidades, planes de lecciones, extractos de fuentes primarias, biografías e ilustraciones) apropiados para estudiantes de los niveles de escuela primaria, intermedia y secundaria. El pueblo católico cuyas historias buscamos contar entendió la fuente y el propósito de la libertad. Se esforzaron por hacer su mundo más amoroso y justo, y prefirieron morir antes que mentir por miedo. Como tales, estos hombres, mujeres y niños pueden ser considerados ejemplos dignos para todas las personas, no sólo para los católicos. Con este fin, estamos desarrollando diversos recursos para su uso en escuelas católicas, cristianas, domésticas e incluso públicas en todo el estado de Florida y más allá. Todos los recursos se calibrarán según los Estándares del Estado del Sol de Florida y buscarán promover en los estudiantes un verdadero afecto por lo que es bueno, verdadero y hermoso. Los recursos de las escuelas católicas considerarán explícitamente el lugar del martirio dentro de la narrativa cristiana más amplia y el llamado universal a la santidad. Los materiales de las escuelas públicas enfatizarán en estas historias las virtudes necesarias para la búsqueda de la justicia y la práctica de la libertad, virtudes que aún siguen siendo relevantes y deseables universalmente en la esfera pública actual.

Contexto mas amplio - Es fácil, pero erróneo, contar la historia del pasado de Florida de una manera que simplifique demasiado la situación y, por lo tanto, pase por alto la increíble dificultad que atravesaron muchas personas con gran gracia y virtud. Esperamos brindar un espacio para comprender a aquellos españoles que a lo largo de su vida se opusieron a la opresión de los pueblos indígenas y a aquellos pueblos indígenas de los Apalachee, Timucua, Guale y otras tribus del Sureste, cuya comprensión de la enseñanza católica guió su oposición a los abusos europeos. Estos pueblos, olvidados por los libros de historia, defendieron juntos la fe y la libertad de La Florida con una perseverancia que duró hasta la muerte. Con la ayuda de la Fundación In God We Trust, las Misiones Negras e Indígenas y la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de Florida, buscamos traducir la buena historia en buenos recursos educativos con el fin de ayudar a los floridanos a encontrar el heroísmo oculto de la historia de su estado.

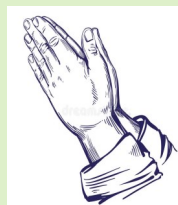
