Location and Significance of the Site

On August 28, 2017, Bishop Bill Wack of Pensacola-Tallahassee, bishop leading the beatification effort, blessed the land and effort.

This peaceful land is located along the old mission road, El Camino Real. Primary documents indicate that on or near this land, just west of the land that once was Mission San Pedro y Pablo de Patale, site of the martyrdom of Fr. Mendoza and his native sacristan, the Last Battle was fought and lost for the Catholic Missions and the Faith in Apalachee (Tallahassee). Servant of God, Baltasar Francisco, was captured at this last stand, tied to an outdoor Cross that surrounded the mission plaza, and was tortured and killed. All the while, he proclaimed the Faith from the cross. Following the devastating loss, the missions would fall like dominoes east across El Camino and the voice of the faithful would be silenced. Yet, God remembers His faithful ones and takes delight in his saints. And the land tells a compelling story, not lost on visitors today.

On a beautiful afternoon on October 12, 2015 the land hosted the opening of the beatification cause!

There is a magnificent home on the back 20 acres that is not part of the design plans for the shrine. The home and 20 acres are available for purchase. We pray that a community or individual buys it to restore it for use as a guest home or ministry. Details can be seen on [Mansion And The Oaks.com](http://MansionAndTheOaks.com)

Peticionario en la Causa de Beatificación Ubicación y significado del sitio

El 28 de agosto de 2017, el obispo Bill Wack de Pensacola-Tallahassee, obispo que encabeza el esfuerzo de beatificación, bendijo la tierra y el esfuerzo. Este tranquilo terreno está ubicado a lo largo del antiguo camino de la misión, El Camino Real. Los documentos primarios indican que en o cerca de esta tierra, justo al oeste de la tierra que una vez fue la Misión San Pedro y Pablo de Patale, lugar del martirio del P. Mendoza y su sacristán natal, la Última Batalla se libró y perdió por las Misiones Católicas y la Fe en Apalachee (Tallahassee). El siervo de Dios, Baltasar Francisco, fue capturado en esta última resistencia, atado a una Cruz al aire libre que rodeaba la plaza de la misión, y fue torturado y asesinado. Mientras tanto, proclamó la Fe desde la cruz. Tras la devastadora pérdida, las misiones caerían como fichas de dominó hacia el este a través de El Camino y la voz de los fieles sería silenciada. Sin embargo, Dios recuerda a sus fieles y se deleita en sus santos. Y la tierra cuenta una historia convincente, que no pasa desapercibida para los visitantes de hoy. ¡En una hermosa tarde del 12 de octubre de 2015 el terreno acogió la apertura de la causa de beatificación!

Hay una casa magnífica en los 20 acres traseros que no forma parte de los planos de diseño del santuario. La casa y 20 acres están disponibles para su compra. Oramos para que una comunidad o un individuo lo compre para restaurarlo y usarlo como casa de huéspedes o ministerio. 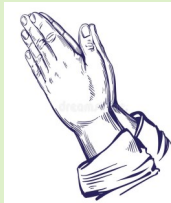
