From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, July 2nd, 2023 – Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle A

Readings: Jeremiah 20:10-13, Psalm 69 “Go out to all the world and tell the Good News”, Romans 5:12-15, Matthew 10:26-33

My dear brothers and sisters, in the first reading an influential woman assists Elisha with lodging in her home and, in return, Elisha wants to do something for her. I can imagine that nice places to stay were few and far between in the ancient world. It is a very grace-filled scene of hospitality and prophets, like Elisha, bore God's blessing to any who helped them. As Christ's disciples today, we must remember the blessing that we can be to others.

As we approach our country's birthday celebrations on July 4th, it is a good time to reflect on our hospitality, or lack of it, toward immigrants. They are essential to the life of our nation; many fill jobs that more established Americans do not want to do. Yet, so many have faced discrimination as we see, even to this day. But being inhospitable, is not the biblical way and it is certainly not Jesus' way.

Many of the children of immigrants would become part of the "Greatest Generation" as they willingly Many immigrants are forced to relocate because of dire circumstances in their home country. I often think about the stories I hear of some immigrants making perilous journeys to escape awful circumstances for the opportunity to have better lives. Hospitality should be our priority for those coming to our shores. Fear of "other" subsides when we encounter immigrants and realize they have the same hopes and dreams as we do. Christ's Spirit is a twofold source of grace, first for the person who bears it and then for any who receive them.

At the Eucharist, we experience God's hospitality. A banquet is prepared for us and we are welcomed in. We received God's hospitality. But we also practice it as we, like the Shumenite woman, discern in this gathering a place where we meet God through one another, the Word and the Eucharistic meal. We welcome the Lord today and, as usual, when we are open to an encounter with God – we receive a blessing. In our society people are gracious and hospitable towards other people like them, their friends, family, business associates, etc. But we note today that biblical hospitality is different. What we know from our scripture readings, Sunday after Sunday, is that God comes to us through other human beings, but most especially in the hungry, poor, homeless, sick, prisoner and stranger. We have a ministry here in Eugene called St. Vincent De Paul. Their mission is “a network of friends, inspired by Gospel values, growing in holiness and building a more just world through personal relationships with and service to people in need.” Volunteerism, therefore, is the heart of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and they work in helping neighbors in need. We are all called to play our part in being hospitals to others. Happy July 4th. May the Lord bless us. In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 2 de julio de 2023 - XIII domingo de tiempo ordinario - Ciclo A

Lecturas: Jeremías 20, 10-13, Salmo 68 “Vayan por todo el mundo y prediquen el Evangelio”, Romanos 5, 12-15, Mateo 10, 26-33

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, en la primera lectura una mujer influyente ayuda a Eliseo a hospedarse en su casa y, a cambio, Eliseo quiere hacer algo por ella. Puedo imaginar que los lugares agradables para quedarse eran pocos y distantes entre sí en el mundo antiguo. Es una escena de hospitalidad muy llena de gracia y los profetas, como Eliseo, llevaron la bendición de Dios a cualquiera que los ayudara. Como discípulos de Cristo hoy, debemos recordar la bendición que podemos ser para los demás.

A medida que nos acercamos a las celebraciones del cumpleaños de nuestro país el 4 de julio, es un buen momento para reflexionar sobre nuestra hospitalidad, o la falta de ella, hacia los inmigrantes. Son esenciales para la vida de nuestra nación; muchos ocupan puestos que los estadounidenses más establecidos no quieren hacer. Sin embargo, muchos han enfrentado discriminación como vemos, incluso hasta el día de hoy. Pero ser inhóspito no es el camino bíblico y ciertamente no es el camino de Jesús.

Muchos de los hijos de inmigrantes se convertirían en parte de la "Generación más grande" ya que Muchos inmigrantes se ven obligados a mudarse debido a las terribles circunstancias en su país de origen. A menudo pienso en las historias que escucho de algunos inmigrantes que hacen viajes peligrosos para escapar de circunstancias terribles y tener la oportunidad de tener una vida mejor. La hospitalidad debe ser nuestra prioridad para quienes vienen a nuestras costas. El miedo a los "otros" desaparece cuando nos encontramos con inmigrantes y nos damos cuenta de que tienen las mismas esperanzas y sueños que nosotros. El Espíritu de Cristo es una doble fuente de gracia, primero para quien lo porta y luego para quien lo recibe.

En la Eucaristía experimentamos la hospitalidad de Dios. Se nos prepara un banquete y se nos da la bienvenida. Recibimos la hospitalidad de Dios. Pero también lo practicamos cuando, como la mujer sumenita, discernimos en esta reunión un lugar donde nos encontramos con Dios a través de los demás, la Palabra y la comida eucarística. Damos la bienvenida al Señor hoy y, como siempre, cuando estamos abiertos a un encuentro con Dios, recibimos una bendición. En nuestra sociedad, las personas son amables y hospitalarias con otras personas como ellos, sus amigos, familiares, socios comerciales, etc. Pero notamos hoy que la hospitalidad bíblica es diferente. Lo que sabemos de nuestras lecturas de las Escrituras, domingo tras domingo, es que Dios viene a nosotros a través de otros seres humanos, pero muy especialmente en los hambrientos, los pobres, los desamparados, los enfermos, los prisioneros y los extraños.
