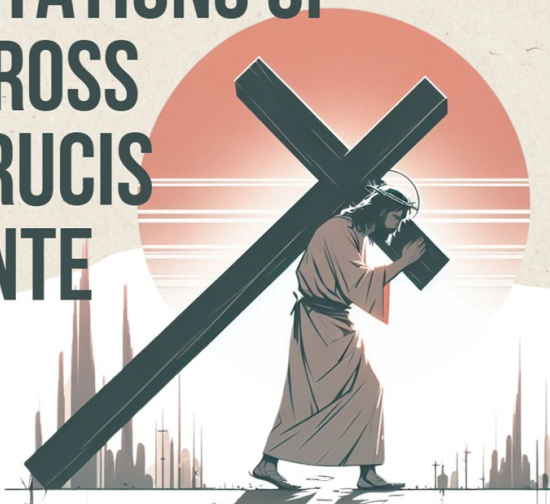

From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, March 17, 2024 – Fifth Sunday of Lent - Cycle B

Readings: Ezequiel 37:12-14, Psalm 130 **“With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption”**, Romans 8:8-11, John 11:1-45

THE HOUR

The Gentiles insisted in seeing Jesus. It is the same insistence that man has of our times. **Jesus is never out of fashion!** There are periods in history particularly marked by the incredible thirst for discovery; just as there is in man's life there comes "the hour" to look for the definitive answer to life's questions. Jesus' hour is marked by pain as a basic condition for fruitfulness.

Sisters and Brothers:

1. Some Gentiles seek to beg Phillip: "We want to see Jesus". How noticeable, the urgency to experiment a joyful encounter with God himself. Isn't this the same request, that millions -with begging urgency- to make believers of us this time? "The Gospel still has something to say to humanity", claimed Roger Garaudy, Marxist philosopher converted to Catholicism. Jesus is still interested in those men, that without knowing are claiming for Him and his Gospel. Jesus has prophesized this: "I will bring all to me".

2. Jesus' life still attracts us, because it is a life completely focused on the Father and to man. Who dares to love and to give himself in this unbounding fashion? Would we be willing to follow Christ with the giving of our own lives? How deep are his words! *"He who loves himself, loses himself, and he who abhors himself in this world will keep himself for eternal life"*. Will we be able to understand the dynamism of love that these words can and should bring about inside of us?

3. The hour for Jesus has arrived. For John, Jesus' hour is that of his death. It is the hour that reveals the meaning of all of his life... his message... and is the moment of triumph because it is in this hour that he fulfills the mission that God entrusted to him.

Jesus' death is the beginning and the way to his glorification. Through the cross to the light, through death to resurrection. Paradoxically, God's glory lies in his death. And, which should our hour be? The same as Jesus': Be a grain of wheat. Die in order to bear fruit, lose to win, choose what is frail to confuse which is strong.

Sisters and Brothers: "We would like to see Jesus." This is the world's most urgent demand today. It depends on us, the "those seeking God", to satisfy this legitimate need. We should be prepared to bring others to join this fascinating endeavor. **"Our Hour" is the one when we discover Jesus** and through Him we set "a new order" in our lives: be holy, love God above all things, and give ourselves to our neighbors so they can become holy too. We must feel the need of God, and be His mirror to give him to others. *"Blessed the pure of heart"*.

Palabras del Párroco

LA HORA

Los gentiles insistían en ver a Jesús. Es la misma inquietud de los hombres de nuestro tiempo. **¡Jesús no pasa de moda!** Hay períodos de la historia particularmente señalados por la sed de descubrimientos; pero también en la vida de cada hombre llega "la hora" de buscar la respuesta definitiva a los interrogantes de la vida. La hora de Jesús está señalada por el dolor como condición de fecundidad.

Hermanas y hermanos:

1. Unos gentiles se acercan a Felipe para rogarle: "Queremos ver a Jesús". Se nota la urgencia de experimentar un feliz encuentro con el mismo Dios ¿No es éste también el ruego que, con urgencia clamorosa, nos hacen llegar a los creyentes millones de hombres de nuestra época? "El Evangelio todavía tiene algo que decir a la humanidad", aseguraba Roger Garaudy, filósofo marxista que se convirtió al catolicismo. Jesús sigue interesando vivamente a los hombres que, aun sin saberlo, están clamando por El y por su Evangelio. Él ya lo había profetizado: "Atraeré a todos hacia mí".

2. La vida de Jesús sigue atrayéndonos, porque es una vida totalmente entregada al Padre y a los hermanos. ¿Quién es capaz de amar y de entregarse de este modo, hasta este extremo? ¿Seremos capaces de seguirle en la entrega de toda nuestra vida? ¿Qué profundas son sus palabras: "El que se ama a sí mismo se pierde, y el que se aborrece a sí mismo en este mundo se guardará para la vida eterna"! ¿Sabremos captar todo el dinamismo de amor que pueden y que deben engendrar en nosotros estas palabras?

3. Ha llegado la hora de Jesús. Para Juan, la hora de Jesús es su muerte. Es la hora que descubre el sentido de toda su vida y su mensaje y es el momento de su triunfo porque con ella lleva a cabo la misión que Dios le encomendó .

La muerte de Jesús es antesala y camino de su exaltación. Por la cruz a la luz, por la muerte a la resurrección. Paradójicamente la gloria de Dios, está en su muerte. Y ¿cuál tiene que ser nuestra hora? La misma de Jesús: Ser grano de trigo. Morir para dar fruto, perder para ganar, escoger lo que es débil para confundir lo que es fuerte.

Hermanas y hermanos: "Quisiéramos ver a Jesús" Es la exigencia más urgente del mundo de hoy. Nos toca a nosotros los "buscadores de Dios", satisfacer esta pretensión legítima. Deberíamos estar preparados para implicar a los otros en esta aventura fascinante. **Es "nuestra hora" cuando descubrimos a Jesús** y por él ponemos un "orden nuevo" en nuestra vida: el de ser santos, amando a Dios sobre todas las cosas y entregándonos a nuestros hermanos para que ellos también lo sean. Tenemos que sentir ansiosamente el deseo de Dios y ser espejo para reflejarlo. "Bienaventurados los limpios de corazón".
