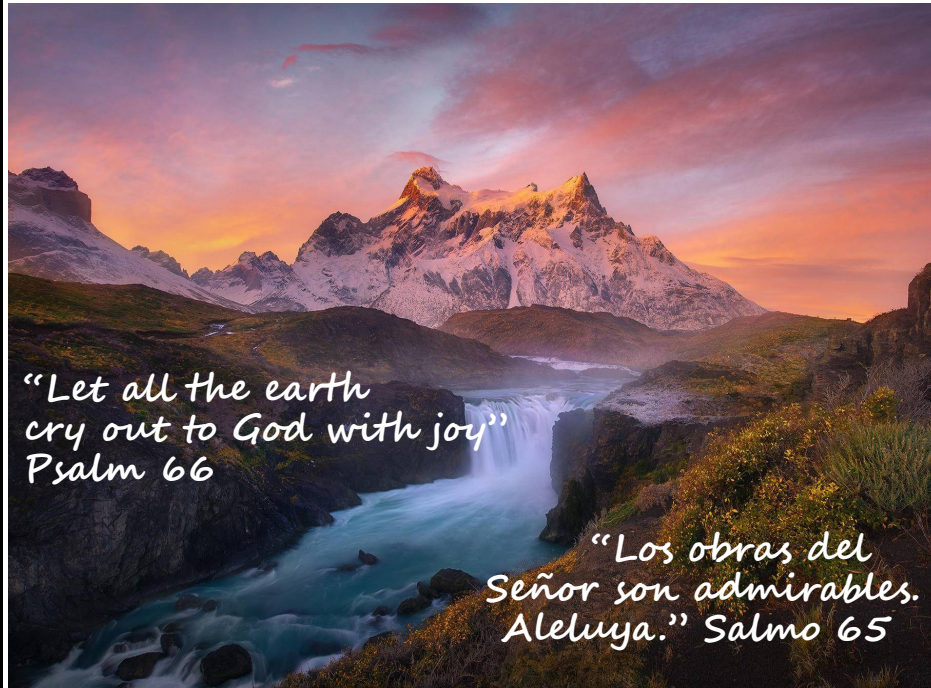

## From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, May 14th, 2023 – Sixth Sunday of Easter - Cycle A

Readings: Acts 8:5-8, 14-17, Psalm 66 “Let all the earth cry out to God with joy”, 1 Peter 3:15-18, John 14:15-21

Today we celebrate the sixth Sunday of Easter, and today is also dedicated in honoring and thanking our earthly mothers for their sacrificial love. Today we celebrate you and wish you a Happy Mother's Day. You have helped many children to become responsible adults. The idea of honoring mothers comes naturally enough because the very concept of motherhood is so honorable and mothers themselves are so lovable: they represent life and love. Mothers are to be cherished, revered, honored, respected and loved. All else at home should be arranged throughout the year and not just one day to honor them. But to ensure that mothers have what they need and that they are honored.

“The month of May is truly a celebration of motherhood. Traditionally, May has been dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is also the time in which we honor and thank our earthly mothers for their sacrificial love. And the Feast of the Visitation on May 31 celebrates the meeting of two mothers—Mary and Elizabeth—both with a child hidden within their wombs.

Scripture tells us that, following the Annunciation, Mary set out *in haste* to visit her cousin Elizabeth, who was pregnant (Lk 1:39). Despite being pregnant herself, Mary undertook the long and likely difficult journey to be at Elizabeth's side. The Blessed Mother's example demonstrates supporting and accompanying mothers, especially those who may be experiencing challenging or difficult circumstances. Yet in a culture that disproportionately values independence and self-reliance, mothers in need are too often left isolated and alone, not knowing where to turn for support or assistance. Mary provides a model of how we, as Catholics, are called to come alongside such mothers.

In addition to “walking with” mothers in love, support, and friendship, we can also help answer their needs for practical and material assistance. Inspired by our Blessed Mother, we can help connect mothers with the Church's extensive network of social services to ensure mothers and their children obtain all the necessities of life. Through generous stewardship of the gifts God has entrusted to us of prayer, time, talent, and treasure, we can help meet the needs of mothers as they welcome and care for God's precious gift of life.” (USCCB).

On this day, we ask the Lord to us the grace to honor mothers always with a spirit of profound respect. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

## Palabras del Párroco

**Domingo, 14 de mayo de 2023 - VI Domingo de Pascua - Ciclo A**

**Lecturas:** Hechos 8, 5-8. 14-17, Salmo 65 "Los obras del Señor son admirables. Aleluya", 1 Pedro 3, 15-18, Juan 14, 15-21

Hoy celebramos el sexto domingo de Pascua, y hoy también está dedicado a honrar y agradecer a nuestras madres terrenales por su amor sacrificado. Hoy te celebramos y te deseamos un Feliz Día de la Madre. Has ayudado a muchos niños a convertirse en adultos responsables. La idea de honrar a las madres surge de manera bastante natural porque el concepto mismo de la maternidad es tan honorable y las madres mismas son tan amables: representan la vida y el amor. Las madres deben ser queridas, reverenciadas, honradas, respetadas y amadas. Todo lo demás en casa debe organizarse durante todo el año y no solo un día para honrarlos. Pero para asegurarse de que las madres tengan lo que necesitan y que sean honradas.

"El mes de mayo es verdaderamente una celebración de la maternidad. Tradicionalmente, el mes de mayo ha sido dedicado a la Santísima Virgen María. También es el momento en que honramos y agradecemos a nuestras madres terrenales por su amor sacrificial. Y la Fiesta de la Visitación, el 31 de mayo, celebra el encuentro de dos madres, María e Isabel, ambas con un niño escondido en sus vientres.

La Escritura nos dice que, después de la Anunciación, María se apresuró a visitar a su prima Isabel, que estaba embarazada (Lc 1,39). A pesar de estar embarazada, Mary emprendió el largo y probablemente difícil viaje para estar al lado de Elizabeth. El ejemplo de la Santísima Madre demuestra el apoyo y el acompañamiento de las madres, especialmente aquellas que pueden estar pasando por circunstancias desafiantes o difíciles. Sin embargo, en una cultura que valora de manera desproporcionada la independencia y la autosuficiencia, las madres necesitadas a menudo se quedan aisladas y solas, sin saber a dónde acudir en busca de apoyo o asistencia. María proporciona un modelo de cómo nosotros, como católicos, estamos llamados a acompañar a tales madres.

Además de "caminar con" las madres en amor, apoyo y amistad, también podemos ayudar a responder a sus necesidades de asistencia práctica y material. Inspirados por nuestra Santísima Madre, podemos ayudar a conectar a las madres con la extensa red de servicios sociales de la Iglesia para garantizar que las madres y sus hijos obtengan todas las necesidades de la vida. A través de la generosa administración de los dones que Dios nos ha confiado de oración, tiempo, talento y tesoro, podemos ayudar a satisfacer las necesidades de las madres mientras reciben y cuidan el precioso regalo de la vida de Dios". Good and gracious God, we thank you for the gift of families.

We are grateful for all of the joy and love that they bring into our lives, and we ask that you provide special protection for all families, particularly those who face hardships as they move in search of a better life.

Show mercy to those who travel in danger, and lead them to a place of safety and peace.

Comfort those who are alone and afraid because their families have been torn apart by violence and injustice.

As we reflect upon the difficult journey that the Holy Family faced as refugees in Egypt, help us to remember the suffering of all migrant families.

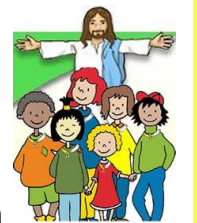
