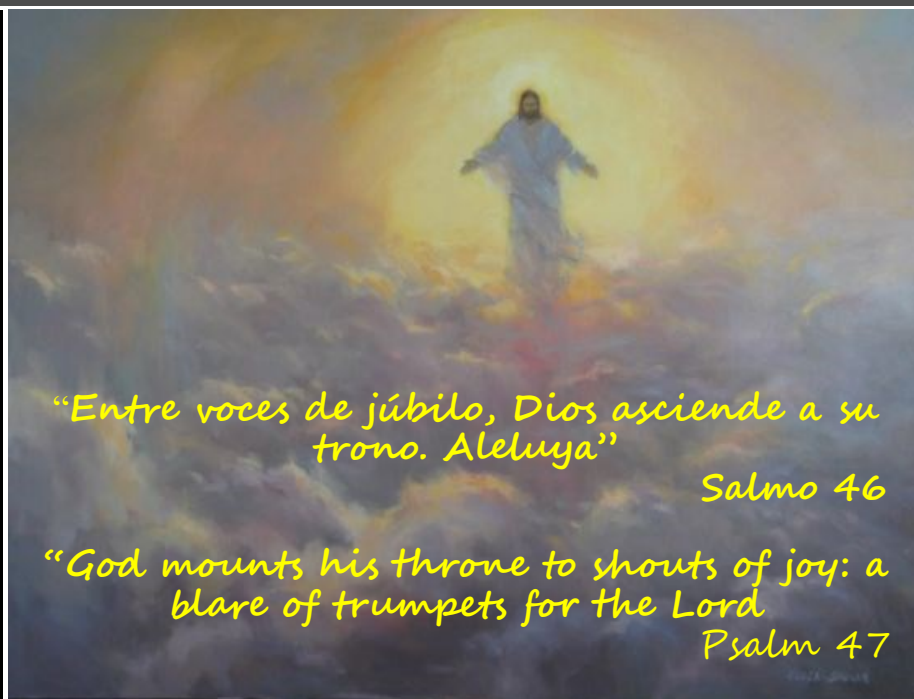

From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, May 21th, 2023 – The Ascension of the Lord - Cycle A

Readings: Acts 1:1-11, Psalm 47 “God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord”, Ephesians 1:17-23, Matthew 28:16-20

We congratulate our fifteen children who will be receiving their first Holy Communion this day of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ. It is our prayer that the reception of the Holy Eucharist helps them to grow stronger in the faith. This year's catechetical program was successful due to the grace of God and the collaboration of our Religious Education coordinators, Catechists and parents. We are very grateful for sharing your time and talents with us. God richly bless you.

Today we celebrate one of the biggest feasts of the liturgical year: The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ. It fulfills the second part of the triumph of Jesus Christ over death. As we profess in the Creed: "... he rose on the third day... and ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father..." We also meditate on it in the second glorious mystery of the Holy Rosary. With the presence of Jesus, the Father will send the Holy Spirit to his followers to fulfill the victory. For a moment our position towards the Ascension is that of the apostles in the first reading. We are left in awe thinking of the glory of God in heaven. However, as the angels awaken the eleven to action, we should consider what the Ascension means today. The gospel today helps us with this task.

The second reading tells that Jesus, seated at the right hand of the Father, has all power in heaven, on earth and also in the future. Because Jesus tells the apostles that he has been given all power, we know that he has already ascended to heaven. He will use the power for the good of all. This is why he says to his apostles: "Go therefore and teach all nations". It is the first step in his plan to renew the world in love.

This phrase is echoed at the end of each Eucharist. After the blessing, the priest or deacon always says: "You may go in peace" sometimes adding "and announce the gospel". Jesus sends us today as his apostles to evangelize the inhabitants of the world. He carries out this mission by "teaching them to do everything I have commanded them".

On this day of ascension, his message and healing power is no longer confined to one pair of feet, one pair of hands. Now in the Church he has a million hearts to beat with his love, a million voices to proclaim his Good News, a million tongues to preach forgiveness of sins and the message of salvation. But a million is not enough if there are still people among us who are still gazing into the "sky". The question is, "Are you still looking into the sky?" if you are, then get to work. The ascension of the Lord, calls us on, challenges us to move beyond the boundaries that are set by our own fear and weakness and sinfulness. Today, as the Lord promises us the Holy Spirit who will empower us to carry on the mission, let us open our hearts to him these coming days as we prepare to celebrate Pentecost. May the Lord bless us with his Spirit. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

Domingo, 21 de mayo de 2023 - Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor - Ciclo A

Lecturas: Hechos 1, 1-11, Salmo 46 "Entre voces de júbilo, Dios asciende a su trono. Aleluya", Efesios 1, 17-23, Mateo 28, 16-20

Felicitemos a nuestros quince niños que están recibiendo su primera Comunión este día de la Ascensión del Señor Jesucristo. Es nuestra oración que la recepción de la Sagrada Eucaristía les ayude a fortalecerse en la fe. El programa de catequesis de este año fue exitoso gracias a la gracia de Dios y la colaboración de nuestros coordinadores de Educación Religiosa, Catequistas y padres. Estamos muy agradecidos por compartir su tiempo y talento con nosotros. Dios te bendiga ricamente.

Hoy celebramos una de las fiestas mayores del año litúrgico: La Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor Jesucristo. Cumple la segunda parte del triunfo de Jesucristo sobre la muerte. Como profesamos en el Credo: "...resucitó al tercer día... y subió a los cielos, y está sentado a la diestra del Padre..." Lo meditamos también en el segundo misterio glorioso de el Santo Rosario. Con la presencia de Jesús, el Padre enviará el Espíritu Santo a sus seguidores para cumplir la victoria. Por un momento nuestra posición frente a la Ascensión es la de los apóstoles en la primera lectura. Nos quedamos asombrados pensando en la gloria de Dios en el cielo. Sin embargo, mientras los ángeles despiertan a los once a la acción, debemos considerar lo que significa la Ascensión hoy. El evangelio de hoy nos ayuda en esta tarea.

La segunda lectura cuenta que Jesús, sentado a la diestra del Padre, tiene todo el poder en el cielo, en la tierra y también en el futuro. Porque Jesús les dice a los apóstoles que se le ha dado todo poder, sabemos que ya subió al cielo. Él usará el poder para el bien de todos. Por eso dice a sus apóstoles: "Id, pues, y haced discípulos a todas las naciones". Es el primer paso de su plan para renovar el mundo en el amor. Esta frase se repite al final de cada Eucaristía. Después de la bendición, el sacerdote o diácono siempre dice: "Puedes irte en paz", añadiendo a veces "y anunciar el evangelio". Jesús nos envía hoy como sus apóstoles a evangelizar a los habitantes del mundo. Él lleva a cabo esta misión "enseñándoles a hacer todo lo que les he mandado".

En este día de ascensión, su mensaje y su poder sanador ya no se limitan a un par de pies, un par de manos. Ahora en la Iglesia tiene un millón de corazones para latir con su amor, un millón de voces para proclamar su Buena Noticia, un millón de lenguas para predicar el perdón de los pecados y el mensaje de salvación. Pero un millón no es suficiente si todavía hay gente entre nosotros que sigue mirando al "cielo". La pregunta es: "¿Sigues mirando al cielo?" si es así, entonces ponte a trabajar. La ascensión del Señor nos llama, nos desafía a ir más allá de los límites establecidos por nuestro propio miedo, debilidad y pecaminosidad. Hoy, como el Señor nos promete el Espíritu Santo que nos dará poder para llevar a cabo la misión, abramos nuestros corazones a él en los próximos días mientras nos preparamos para celebrar Pentecostés. Que el Señor nos bendiga con su Espíritu. En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo. Amén
