## From the Pastor's Desk...

**Sunday, May 28th, 2023 – Pentecost Sunday - Cycle A**

**Readings:** Acts 2:1-11, Psalm 104 “**Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth**”, 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13, John 20:19-23

We congratulate our thirty one parishioners who will be confirmed this Sunday by Bishop William Wack. Confirmation completes the sacraments of initiation. We are born anew by baptism, strengthened by confirmation, and receive the food of eternal life in the Eucharist. We pray that the Lord, through the power of the Holy Spirit, strengthens the gifts he gave to our brothers and sisters on the day of their baptism and make them his worthy instruments of peace, joy, and renewed hope in the world. Also four of our confirmands will be receiving their first Holy Communion. We are very grateful to all the Catechists and those who have journeyed with them for their love and service in sharing the faith to our dear brothers and sisters. May the almighty God richly bless you.

My dear brothers and sisters, we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. The birthday of the church, the day the Lord fulfilled his promise that he will not leave us alone. The first reading and the gospel present the descent of the Holy Spirit differently. The stories of Luke and John compliment each other and teach us that the Spirit is the new law, the power that enables humankind to do good. The Spirit is the source of unity (does away with barriers) and whatever the Holy Spirit is, the power and presence of God is felt. The second reading invites us to see the consequences of the presence of the Spirit in a community.

After Pentecost the Church struggles to live the language of the Spirit. In the second reading we hear Paul reminding the divided community at Corinth that their diverse gifts are for the good of the community. It is the one dynamic Spirit which is the source of the community's gifts. And the Spirit which fired the apostles and which enthused Paul is the same Spirit which fires and enthuses us. The Spirit does that in our own mundane attempts to work at forgiveness and love and understanding. That is the language of the Spirit. Forgiveness, love and understanding form a language which everyone understands and needs to hear. That is the language we are invited to speak and the promise is that when we speak it people will recognize it as their own language. They can truly say that we are speaking their language because it is the language which has no boundaries, and no special dictionaries are needed to understand it. It is the language of the Spirit. It is the language of love: the language that all people understand. As we celebrate this solemnity, may the Lord bless us, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

**Domingo, 28 de mayo de 2023 - Domingo de Pentecostés- Ciclo A**

**Lecturas:** Hechos 2,1-11, Salmo 103 “Envía, Señor, tu Espíritu, a renovar la tierra. Aleluya”, 1 Corintios 12,3b-7. 12-13, Juan 20,19-23

Felicitemos a nuestros treinta y un feligreses que serán confirmados este domingo por el obispo William Wack. La confirmación completa los sacramentos de iniciación. Nacemos de nuevo por el bautismo, fortalecidos por la confirmación, y recibimos el alimento de la vida eterna en la Eucaristía. Oramos para que el Señor, por el poder del Espíritu Santo, fortalezca los dones que entregó a nuestros hermanos y hermanas en el día de su bautismo y los convierta en sus dignos instrumentos de paz, alegría y esperanza renovada en el mundo. También cuatro de nuestros confirmandos estarán recibiendo su primera Comunión. Estamos muy agradecidos con todos los catequistas y aquellos que han caminado con ellos por su amor y servicio al compartir la fe con nuestros queridos hermanos y hermanas. Que el Dios Todopoderoso te bendiga ricamente.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, celebramos el domingo de Pentecostés. El cumpleaños de la iglesia, el día que el Señor cumplió su promesa de que no nos dejará solos. La primera lectura y el evangelio presentan de manera diferente la venida del Espíritu Santo. Las historias de Lucas y Juan se complementan y nos enseñan que el Espíritu es la nueva ley, el poder que permite a la humanidad hacer el bien. El Espíritu es la fuente de unidad (elimina las barreras) y sea lo que sea el Espíritu Santo, se siente el poder y la presencia de Dios. La segunda lectura nos invita a ver las consecuencias de la presencia del Espíritu en una comunidad.

Después de Pentecostés la Iglesia lucha por vivir el lenguaje del Espíritu. En la segunda lectura, escuchamos a Pablo recordar a la comunidad dividida de Corinto que sus diversos dones son para el bien de la comunidad. Es el único Espíritu dinámico que es la fuente de los dones de la comunidad. Y el Espíritu que incendia a los apóstoles y que entusiasmó a Pablo es el mismo Espíritu que incendia y entusiasma a nosotros. El Espíritu hace eso en nuestros propios intentos mundanos de obrar en el perdón, el amor y la comprensión. Ese es el lenguaje del Espíritu.

El perdón, el amor y la comprensión forman un lenguaje que todos entienden y necesitan escuchar. Ese es el idioma que estamos invitados a hablar y la promesa es que cuando lo hablemos, la gente lo reconocerá como su propio idioma. Realmente pueden decir que estamos hablando su idioma porque es el idioma que no tiene fronteras y no se necesitan diccionarios especiales para entenderlo. Es el lenguaje del Espíritu. Es el lenguaje del amor: el lenguaje que todas las personas entienden. Al celebrar esta solemnidad, que el Señor nos bendiga, en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
