From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, May 7th, 2023 – Fifth Sunday - Cycle A

Readings: Acts 6:1-7, Psalm 33 “Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you”, 1 Peter 2:4-9, John 14:1-12

My dear brothers and sisters, on this weekend many of our children and grandchildren, friends and family are graduating. We share in their joy and accomplishments and we pray for the blessings of God upon them and their heart desires. We say congratulations!

Today's Gospel presents us with the beautiful words of Jesus at the Last Supper. Jesus begins by speaking of peace: “Do not lose your peace”, knowing that very soon, he is going to go through his own passion. However, he wants the disciples to have faith in him, despite everything that is going to happen. We understand the confusion of the disciples. Jesus is saying that, yes, he is going, but he is going to prepare a place for them. We heard the doubt of Thomas, “Lord, we do not know where you are going, how can we know the way?”, and also of Felipe, “Lord, show us the Father and that is enough for us.” They are the feelings we have when life seems difficult. We walk in confusion and look for proof that we are on the right track. Many of us find comfort in the words of Jesus: “I am the way, the truth and the life. No one goes to the Father if he is not through me.” The three qualifications: way, truth and life are applied to Jesus to indicate his three functions as mediator, revealer, and Savior. He is the only way to the Father. He is the only way to peace, joy, love, and hope. “Do not lose your peace.” This peace of Jesus is a peace that does not depend on politics. It is a peace that comes from God.

In reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the author tells us that there were certain complaints from the Greek Jews against the Hebrews. It seems that there was discrimination in the attention to the widows of the Greeks. To solve the problem, the Twelve summoned a multitude of disciples and a solution was proposed. It is interesting that they left the decision to choose the helpers to the community. It was a community decision to recognize men filled with the Holy Spirit and wisdom for the service of the poor. They fixed the issue with the help of the community. We have hope in the vision that Saint Peter had of the Church when he told the community, “You are a chosen lineage, a royal priesthood, a nation consecrated to God and a people of his property, so that you may proclaim the marvelous works of him who called you from the darkness to his marvelous light.” It is true that we are weak, but if we open our hearts to the power of the Holy Spirit, we can live as witnesses of the wonders that God does through his Church.

We find solace in these readings. We know that the Church has always gone through difficulties, but the power of the Spirit carries it forward. Jesus tells us clearly, “Do not lose your peace.” May he bless us with his presence in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Palabras del Párroco

Domingo, 7 de mayo de 2023 - V Domingo de Pascua - Cielo A

Lecturas: Hechos 6, 1-7, Salmo 32 “El Señor cuida de aquellos que lo temen. Aleluya”, 1 Pedro 2, 4-9, Juan 14, 1-12

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, en este fin de semana se graduarán muchos de nuestros hijos y nietos, amigos y familiares. Compartimos su alegría y logros y oramos por las bendiciones de Dios sobre ellos y los deseos de su corazón. Decimos ¡felicidades!

El Evangelio de hoy nos presenta las hermosas palabras de Jesús en la Última Cena. Jesús comienza hablando de la paz: “No perdáis la paz”, sabiendo que muy pronto va a pasar por su propia pasión. Sin embargo, quiere que los discípulos tengan fe en él, a pesar de todo lo que va a pasar. Entendemos la confusión de los discípulos. Jesús está diciendo que sí, que se va, pero que les va a preparar un lugar. Escuchamos la duda de Tomás, “Señor, no sabemos a dónde vas, ¿cómo podemos saber el camino?”, y también de Felipe, “Señor, muéstranos al Padre y eso nos basta”. Son los sentimientos que tenemos cuando la vida parece difícil. Caminamos en la confusión y buscamos pruebas de que estamos en el camino correcto.

Muchos de nosotros encontramos consuelo en las palabras de Jesús: “Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida. Nadie va al Padre si no es por mí.” Las tres calificaciones: camino, verdad y vida se aplican a Jesús para indicar sus tres funciones de él como mediador, revelador y Salvador. Él es el único camino al Padre. Él es el único camino a la paz, la alegría, el amor y la esperanza. “No pierdas la paz”. Esta paz de Jesús es una paz que no depende de la política. Es una paz que viene de Dios.

Al leer los Hechos de los Apóstoles, el autor nos dice que hubo ciertas quejas de los judíos griegos contra los hebreos. Parece que hubo discriminación en la atención a las viudas de los griegos. Para solucionar el problema, los Doce convocaron a una multitud de discípulos y se propuso una solución. Es interesante que dejaron la decisión de elegir a los ayudantes a la comunidad. Fue una decisión comunitaria reconocer a hombres llenos del Espíritu Santo y de sabiduría para el servicio de los pobres. Solucionaron el problema con la ayuda de la comunidad. Tenemos esperanza en la visión que San Pedro tuvo de la Iglesia cuando dijo a la comunidad: “Vosotros sois linaje escogido, real sacerdocio, nación consagrada a Dios y pueblo de su propiedad, para que anunciéis las obras maravillosas de aquel que os llamó de las tinieblas a su luz admirable.” Es cierto que somos débiles, pero si abrimos nuestro corazón al poder del Espíritu Santo, podemos vivir como testigos de las maravillas que Dios hace a través de su Iglesia.

Encontramos consuelo en estas lecturas. Sabemos que la Iglesia siempre ha pasado por dificultades, pero el poder del Espíritu la saca adelante. Jesús nos dice claramente: “No perdáis la paz”. Que nos bendiga con su presencia en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén.
