From the Pastor's Desk...

Sunday, September 24th, 2023 – Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time - Cycle A

Readings: Isaiah 55:6-9, Psalm 145 "The Lord is near to all who call upon him", Philipians 1:20c-24, 27a, Matthew 20:1-16a

GENEROUS SERVICE

God is love. Love does not contradict justice, but rather, enhances it. The parable of the laborers helps us see the heart of Christ. Beyond all expectations, he gives the same opportunity and reward to all. The mission of a Christian consists in freely loving and serving others without reserve. How far we are from meeting this ideal!

Brothers and sisters:

1. God loves us for who we are and not for what we do. This parable isn't aiming at teaching us how to be landowners, workers, or laborers, but it speaks to us about life in the kingdom of God. It's hard for us to accept that God's ways are not our ways. Christ comes to us as a generous landowner who doesn't pay according to how much we get done, but from a free and unmerited love. "Not as we deserve, but according to your goodness." This is the good news of the Gospel.

2. We're making a big mistake when we seek to apply our human standards of justice, which are always unjust, to God. Instead of trying to become like God, we try to make him more like us: applying calculations, taxes, expenses, and salaries. We want to make a deal with God. We want instant payment for the time we dedicate to his work, which practically reduces us to the level of employees who fulfill certain rites without any personal commitment, who pray without putting any heart into it and who participate in the Sacraments without any fervor. We want a "just" God, who gives each one his due; the one who does more deserves more, and the one who does less, less. We want a meticulous account of all that we've done so that we can be paid proportionally, fairly.

3. The God of this parable is a generous God who doesn't limit his gifts to what we deserve. He gives without expecting anything back; he chooses to love us for who we are and not for what we do. The laborers weren't irritated on account of being underpaid; but they felt they were victims of some injustice because they witnessed the landowner's love and goodness towards the others.

There are Christians who believe that religion is about what they give to God. But no, religion is about what God gives to us. This is the mindset of mercenaries. They don't capture how dangerous it is to demand "what is just" from God. The true laborer, after the Lord's heart, doesn't care about his salary. His delight is to work for the Kingdom of God.

It is a gift to be called to serve Christ. But when our encounter with God through faith happens after a long waiting period, we're speaking of a free and generous gift. We should always look to the things that are above, opening our hearts to welcome the gift of God and tell him: Thank you Lord! This is what we are going to do now as we continue the Celebration of the Eucharist..

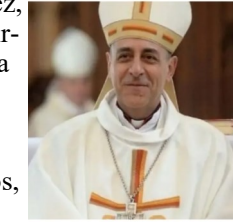

Mes de la Herencia Hispana
5 nuevos cardenales de América Latina que el Papa creará en septiembre

El Papa Francisco anunció que el próximo 30 de septiembre de 2023 tendrá lugar un consistorio para la creación de 21 nuevos cardenales, de los cuales 5 son de América Latina. Hay 3 de Argentina, 1 de Colombia y 1 de Venezuela. Estos son los nuevos cardenales de América Latina que el Papa Francisco creará en agosto

1. "Tucho" Fernández, nuevo Prefecto del Dicasterio para la Doctrina de la Fe. Como era de esperar, el Papa Francisco creará un cardenal al recién nombrado Prefecto del Dicasterio para la Doctrina de la Fe, el argentino Mons. Víctor Manuel Fernández, conocido popularmente como "Tucho". El hasta ahora Arzobispo de la Plata (Argentina) será elevado a la púrpura cardenalicia el próximo 30 de septiembre, pocos días después de situarse oficialmente al frente de uno de los dicasterios más relevantes de la Santa Sede.



El Prelado argentino, que el 18 de julio cumplirá 61 años, es considerado el "teólogo del Papa Francisco" y el "ghost writer" (el escritor "fantasma") detrás de varios de los escritos del Pontífice, entre ellos su Exhortación Apostólica Amoris Laetitia.

Mons. Fernández obtuvo la licenciatura en Teología con especialización bíblica en la Pontificia Universidad Gregoriana (Roma) y posteriormente el doctorado en Teología en la Facultad de Teología de Buenos Aires. Ha sido formador de seminario, director para el ecumenismo y director de catequesis. De 2008 a 2009 fue decano de la Facultad de Teología de la Pontificia Universidad Católica Argentina y Presidente de la Sociedad Teológica Argentina. Muy poco después de iniciar su pontificado en marzo de 2013, el Papa Francisco lo nombró Arzobispo el 13 de mayo, sin asignarle una jurisdicción a cargo. Para entonces, ya se desempeñaba desde 2011 como rector de la Pontificia Universidad Católica Argentina Santa María de los Buenos Aires (UCA).

Cinco años después, el 2 de junio de 2018, fue nombrado Arzobispo de La Plata, cargo en el que sucedió a Mons. Héctor Aguer. Este nuevo nombramiento ha estado sujeto a cierta polémica en los últimos días debido, entre otros temas, a que en 1995, tras 10 años de haber sido ordenado sacerdote, el entonces P. Fernández publicó en Argentina con la editorial Lumen el libro "Sáname con tu boca. El arte de besar", texto que no aparece en el listado de obras que el Vaticano dio a conocer el pasado 1 de julio. Sobre esta publicación, "Tucho" explicó que "en aquel momento yo era muy joven, era párroco, y trataba de llegar a los jóvenes. Entonces se me ocurrió escribir una catequesis para adolescentes a partir de lo que significa el beso. Esa catequesis la escribí con la participación de un grupo de jóvenes que me aportó ideas, frases, poemas, etc."

2. Mons. Angel Sixto Rossi, Arzobispo de Córdoba (Argentina)

Mons. Rossi nació en Córdoba (Argentina) en 1958 y fue admitido al noviciado en la Compañía de Jesús en 1976. Actualmente tiene 64 años.

Hizo sus estudios en filosofía y teología en Ecuador, recibió la ordenación sacerdotal el 12 de diciembre de 1986. Ocho años más tarde, hizo sus votos solemnes en la Compañía de Jesús. Además, es graduado en teología espiritual por la Pontificia Universidad Gregoriana en Roma. En Argentina, entre diversas responsabilidades dentro de la Compañía de Jesús, y además de publicar libros espirituales y pastorales, Mons. Rossi fundó el Hogar San José y la Fundación Manos Abiertas, que atienden a personas en situación vulnerable y de calle.

5 new cardinals from Latin America that the Pope will create in September

Pope Francis announced that a consistory will take place on September 30, 2023 for the creation of 21 new cardinals, of which 5 are from Latin America. There are 3 from Argentina, 1 from Colombia and 1 from Venezuela. These are the new cardinals of Latin America that Pope Francis will create in August

1. "Tucho" Fernández, new Prefect of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith. As expected, Pope Francis will create a cardinal upon receiving the Argentine Mons. Víctor Manuel Fernández, popularly known as "Tucho", as Prefect of the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith. The until now Archbishop of La Plata (Argentina) will be elevated to the cardinal's purple on September 30, a few days after officially taking charge of one of the most relevant dicasteries of the Holy See.

The Argentine Prelate, who will turn 61 on July 18, is considered the "theologian of Pope Francis" and the "ghost writer" behind several of the Pontiff's writings, including his Apostolic Exhortation Amoris Leticia.

Mons. Fernández obtained a bachelor's degree in Theology with biblical specialization at the Pontifical Gregorian University (Rome) and later a doctorate in Theology at the Faculty of Theology of Buenos Aires. He has been a seminary trainer, director for ecumenism and director of catechesis. From 2008 to 2009 he was dean of the Faculty of Theology of the Pontifical Catholic University of Argentina and President of the Argentine Theological Society. Very shortly after beginning his pontificate in March 2013, Pope Francis named him Archbishop on May 13, without assigning him a jurisdiction in charge. By then, he had already served since 2011 as rector of the Pontifical Catholic University of Argentina Santa María de los Buenos Aires (UCA).

Five years later, on June 2, 2018, he was named Archbishop of La Plata, a position in which he succeeded Bishop Héctor Aguer. This new appointment has been subject to some controversy in recent days due, among other issues, to the fact that in 1995, after 10 years of having been ordained a priest, the then Father Fernández published in Argentina with the Lumen publishing house the book "Heal me with your mouth. The art of kissing", a text that does not appear in the list of works that the Vatican released on July 1. Regarding this publication, "Tucho" explained that "at that time I was very young, I was a parish priest, and I was trying to reach young people. Then it occurred to me to write a catechism for adolescents based on what the kiss means. That catechism was "I wrote with the participation of a group of young people who gave me ideas, phrases, poems, etc."

2. Bishop Angel Sixto Rossi, Archbishop of Córdoba (Argentina)

Bishop Rossi was born in Córdoba (Argentina) in 1958 and was admitted to the novitiate in the Society of Jesus in 1976. He is currently 64 years old.

He studied philosophy and theology in Ecuador, and received priestly ordination on December 12, 1986. Eight years later, he made his solemn vows in the Society of Jesus. Additionally, he has a degree in spiritual theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. In Argentina, among various responsibilities within the Society of Jesus, and in addition to publishing spiritual and pastoral books, Mons. Rossi founded the Hogar San José and the Manos Abiertas Foundation, which serve vulnerable and homeless people.

SERVIR DESINTERESADAMENTE

Dios es amor. El amor no se opone a la justicia sino que va más allá. La parábola de los jornaleros hace una fotografía del corazón de Cristo que da la misma oportunidad a todos y que recompensa por encima de todas las expectativas. La misión del cristiano consiste en servir a los demás con una actitud de entrega sin condiciones, con libertad y con amor. ¡Qué lejos estamos de ese ideal de perfección!

Hermanas y hermanos:

1. Dios nos ama por lo que somos y no por lo que hacemos. Esta parábola no pretende instruirnos sobre propietarios, trabajadores y jornales, sino hablarnos de lo que ocurre con el Reino de Dios. Nos cuesta entender que los caminos del Señor son distintos de los nuestros. El se presenta como un amo generoso que no toma en cuenta la rentabilidad de nuestras acciones, sino que nos paga con un amor gratuito e inmerecido. "No por nuestros méritos sino conforme a tu bondad". Esta es la buena noticia del evangelio.

2. Cometemos un grave error cuando queremos aplicar la medida de nuestra justicia humana que siempre va a ser injusta. En vez de parecernos a Dios, intentamos que él se parezca a nosotros con salarios, tarifas, comisiones y porcentajes. Queremos comerciar con él y que nos pague puntualmente el tiempo que le dedicamos, que prácticamente se reduce al empleado en unos ritos sin compromiso, a unas oraciones sin corazón, a unos sacramentos sin fervor. Queremos un Dios "justo", que dé a cada uno lo "suyo", que dé más a quien más produce y menos a quien rinde menos, que lleve minuciosamente la contabilidad de cuanto hacemos para pagarnos por ello de modo proporcionado, equitativo.

3. El Dios que nos presenta la parábola es el Dios generoso que no condiciona sus dones a nuestros méritos, el Dios que no espera recibir para dar, el Dios gratuito que nos ama por nosotros y no por lo que hacemos. El que encuentra la propia alegría en poder trabajar por el Reino.

Ser llamados al servicio de Cristo es una gracia; pero cuando nuestro encuentro con Dios en la fe tiene lugar después de mucho tiempo de espera, podemos hablar de un don gratuito y generoso. Siempre debemos mirar arriba, abrir los corazones para acoger el don de Dios, y decirle: ¡Gracias, Señor! Eso es lo que ahora vamos a hacer en la eucaristía.

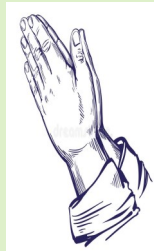
